Terrapin Tap House/Cigar and Smoke Lounge will offer a large selection of craft beers from the Terrapin Brewery, based in Athens, Ga. Located on the upper level of Concourse D, Terrapin will feature more than 50 beers. Food offerings include a variety of specialty flatbreads with pimento cheese, bacon and caramelized onions or chicken sausage with apples and red onions.
