Hartsfield-Jackson to Become a Winter Wonderland during Holiday Season

Tree lighting ceremony marks start of holiday events held throughout Airport;100 millionth passenger expected to arrive in December

ATLANTA – Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) officials will begin a month-long series of holiday events with a tree lighting ceremony Tuesday morning, December 1. Airport General Manger Miguel Southwell will be joined by Holiday carolers, Airport guests, volunteers, employees, and mascots of Atlanta-based teams and companies to officially light the tree in the Airport's Atrium.

Airport officials will also announce that in December, Hartsfield-Jackson will pass the 100-million passenger mark. This will be the first time in the history of aviation that an airport has ever served 100 million passengers in a single year.

On Wednesday, December 2, more than 500 Airport-area first-graders will participate in ATL Presents: Toyland, a program designed to spread holiday cheer among metro Atlanta's youth while educating them about the global world in which they live. Airport partners and concessionaires will provide food and gifts to the students, while the Georgia Consular Corps will inform them about holidays around the world. Santa is also expected to make an appearance.
