Dramatic Final Pitch Event To Conclude Hartsfield-Jackson Tech Ideation Event

ATL Thinks! offered nation's best and brightest a chance to solve real-world air transportation challenges; final round pitch competition tonight provides compelling close to event.

ATLANTA – Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) will conclude ATL Thinks!, an innovative technology development event focusing on the air transportation and logistics industries Tuesday night, December 15th. The five-day Ideation Launch was a combination hackathon, collaboration, and pitch show designed to solve real-world air transportation problems. Entrepreneurs and engineers whose skills range from novice designer to professional developer had an opportunity to address challenges faced by airports across the world. Participants selected a specific challenge, worked with a mentor to address the needs created by that challenge, and then pitched their solution to senior managers from ATL. Tonight's final pitch event will offer a dramatic conclusion to ATL Thinks! and could provide a starting point for a future business leader. Successful teams may end up working with ATL to implement their proposed solution. The event concludes Tuesday, December 15th, but the collaboration does not. ATL Thinks! is a program that seeks ongoing dialogue and activation from the community of participating innovators.

Program judges include Hartsfield-Jackson General Manager Miguel Southwell, former Georgia Department of Economic Development Commissioner Craig Lesser, Dr. Eloisa Klementich of Invest Atlanta, and representatives from a variety of prominent Atlanta-based businesses.
