Live Video Feed Available for Hartsfield-Jackson's 100 Million Passenger Historic Milestone

ATL to become first airport ever to serve 100 million passengers in a single year Satellite coordinates in advisory below for stations interested in airing aircraft arrival

ATLANTA – Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) officials, working closely with accounting firm KPMG, have determined the Airport will host its 100-millionth passenger Sunday, December 27. This is the first time ever a single airport has served 100 million passengers in one calendar year. Based on statistical modeling and on scheduled arrival and departure times, the Airport has identified the flight which will mark the 100 million passenger milestone.

This unique event will take place at the gate and behind the security checkpoint. ATL will provide a live, three-camera feed of the aircraft's arrival and the passengers' entry into the concourse. The feed will be made available via satellite and a live web stream. Journalists wishing to cover the event in person must RSVP to <u>media@atlanta-airport.com</u> by Thursday, December 24 at noon (please include "ATL 100 million arrival" in the email's subject line) and must include their full name and date of birth for security vetting purposes.

The satellite window will open at 0730 and will close at 0930.
