Hartsfield-Jackson to Celebrate Air Cargo Leaders

Cargo carriers to be honored for achievements in growth, business development

ATLANTA – Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) officials will host the annual ATL Cargo Awards celebration Wednesday, May 4. The luncheon honors businesses and leaders for their achievements in air cargo, welcomes new cargo carriers to ATL, and features a look at burgeoning cargo opportunities at ATL.

The world's most traveled airport, Hartsfield-Jackson made history last year as the first airport ever to serve more than 100 million passengers in a single year. Cargo traffic at ATL experienced substantial growth with a 4 percent increase in freight tonnage in 2015 over 2014 totals. 2015 also saw ATL transport its largest piece of cargo ever when a 200-ton power turbine was flown from Hartsfield-Jackson to Argentina.

Airport officials will discuss the importance of ATL cargo development as an economic driver for the region along with plans to increase such development.
