Project will facilitate business growth at world's busiest airport

ATLANTA – Atlanta Mayor Kasim Reed will be joined by members of the Majestic and Carter development teams, along with officials from Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL), on Tuesday, Nov. 15 to provide new information on the hotel and conference center to be built at the world's busiest airport. The 440-room, four-star hotel – just steps from the Domestic Terminal – will be part of a mixed-used development project that includes a conference center and 50,000 square feet of office space.
