Hartsfield-Jackson to Hold Full-Scale Emergency Disaster Drill

Firefighters, law enforcement, rescue personnel and nearly 100 volunteers set to participate in the triennial 'Big Bird' exercise

WHO:

Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, Atlanta Police Department, Atlanta Fire and Rescue Department.

WHAT:

Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport is preparing for its Big Bird emergency drill. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requires airports to conduct annual emergency preparedness drills and at least one full-scale drill every three years. The Airport has dubbed this drill Big Bird. The event will replicate a full-scale airplane disaster response in which airport personnel will ignite an aircraft, extinguish the fire, and treat and triage nearly 100 "victims" portrayed by volunteers.

Airport officials will host a media briefing and walkthrough day on Monday, April, 13.
