Hartsfield-Jackson and Frontier Airlines Announce New Service from Atlanta to Six New U.S Destinations

Fares as low as \$19 to celebrate new service

ATLANTA – Hartsfield-Jackson and Frontier Airlines officials today announced new non-stop service between Atlanta and six new cities including Cincinnati, Los Angeles, New York – LaGuardia, Minneapolis and New Orleans. Frontier started new nonstop service to Las Vegas on Wednesday.

"For the second time this year, we are thrilled that Frontier Airlines will start new service from Atlanta," said Miguel Southwell, general manager, Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. "Additional non-stop routes from Atlanta are not only good for business, but it gives our customers more choice and greater access. I have no doubt that customers will greatly enjoy this new service."

The airline announced a special one-day only sale with fares of just \$19 - \$99 to all 16 destinations Frontier serves nonstop from Atlanta. Tickets must be purchased at flyfrontier.com by 11:59 pm Eastern time on Apr. 30, 2015 for travel from May 5 through Jun. 10, 2015.

"The launch of this new service marks an exciting day for both the Atlanta area and Frontier," said Daniel Shurz, senior vice president - commercial for Frontier Airlines. "For Atlanta, it means more low fares to more destinations, and for Frontier, it's a growth opportunity because of the response from the local community."

During today's announcement, travelers were able to collect travel dollars by stepping into Frontier's "Flying Bucks Frenzy" cash cube. Passengers had 15 seconds to collect as many travel dollars as possible. Dozens participated and they will be sent a travel voucher which can be redeemed for travel to any of Frontier's destinations.

In addition to the new cities launched today, Frontier offers nonstop service from Atlanta to Austin, Texas; Chicago O'Hare; Cleveland; Denver; Indianapolis; Miami; Orlando, Fla.; Philadelphia; Trenton, N.J.; and Washington - Dulles.
