Busy Holiday Weekend Kicks Off With Travel Tips, Celebration

Hartsfield-Jackson prepares for substantial passenger traffic increase

ATLANTA – With indicators pointing to a busy holiday weekend, officials at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport will release projected holiday travel numbers at a press conference on Wednesday. To ease the expected travel rush, airport management suggests passengers arrive early.

"The combination of an improved economy and Independence Day falling on a Saturday will lead to more passengers over the weekend," said Hartsfield-Jackson General Manager Miguel Southwell. "Domestic passengers are encouraged to arrive at least two hours prior to their domestic departure, and two and a half hours before departure for international flights."

Research conducted by automobile club AAA says air travel over the holiday weekend will increase 1.5 percent over last year's numbers across the U.S. Nationwide, more than 3.2 million people will be traveling by air.

Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, the busiest and most efficient airport in the world, will release its projected holiday travel numbers at a press conference Wednesday morning. At that time, airport officials will also kick-off an Independence Day weekend-long customer appreciation celebration. The event, called "Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Flying," will provide a stirring visual component to the weekend festivities.
