Hartsfield-Jackson to exceed national travel projections

Atlanta airport prepares for busy Independence Day weekend; Passengers are urged to budget plenty of time before departure

ATLANTA – Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International officials announced today that Atlanta's passenger traffic will exceed the national average of AAA's expected 1.5 percent increase over last year's nationwide holiday weekend air travel numbers.

Hartsfield-Jackson, the busiest and most efficient airport in the world will host a projected 327,170 passengers during the holiday weekend. This represents a fourteen percent increase over the same four-day period last year when 285,606 passengers flew out of Hartsfield-Jackson.

Due to the spike in volume, domestic passengers are reminded to arrive at least two hours prior to scheduled departure. International passengers are directed to arrive two and a half hours before departure.

"Today marks the beginning of a busy travel weekend with more than 47,000 passengers clearing the security checkpoints," said Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport General Manager Miguel Southwell. "A strong economy and a weekend holiday make for a busy air travel period. We're looking forward to giving our passengers an efficient and smooth travel experience."

Hartsfield-Jackson officials today marked the beginning of the Independence Day weekend with a campaign designed to celebrate the airport's guests and thank them for making Hartsfield-Jackson part of their travel plans. The campaign, called Life, Liberty And The Pursuit Of Flying, consists of volunteers handing out treats and, in conjunction with the airport's Arts Program, a series of musical performances celebrating a variety of American musical genres. The performances will take place throughout the weekend.

Hartsfield-Jackson's website (<u>www.atlanta-airport.com</u>) allows travelers to check parking availability and security wait times. Through the website's Trak-A-Line link, travelers can sign up and receive real time wait times via email or text. The Trak-A-Flight link offers the same for flight information.
