Hartsfield-Jackson Wins Top Global Efficiency Excellence Award

Airport Again Named World's Most Efficient

ATLANTA – Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport has been named the world's most efficient airport for the 12th consecutive year.

In its annual benchmarking study of commercial airports in Europe, Asia, Oceania and North America, the Air Transport Research Society (ATRS), the world's leading academic society in the air transportation field, has again given its Global Efficiency Excellence Award for large airports to Hartsfield-Jackson.

ATRS reviewed the productivity and efficiency of more than 200 airports worldwide and based its top award on factors such as passenger and cargo traffic, plane movements, flight bookings, landing fees and terminal charges, and percentage of airport revenue coming from non-aviation sources. Greater efficiency in the airport industry typically results in stronger financial stability and lower costs for travelers.

"This award stands as a testament to Hartsfield-Jackson's unwavering dedication to operational and managerial efficiency and cost competitiveness," said Aviation General Manager Miguel Southwell. "We are proud to have claimed this recognition for the 12th consecutive year."

Professor Martin Dresner, President and CEO of ATRS, described Hartsfield-Jackson and the regional winners as "airports that serve as the benchmarks for the industry."

"Each year, the ATRS analyzes data on airport costs and outputs in order to arrive at the most efficient airports in all the major regions of the world," added Dresner. "As the aviation industry has become more competitive, airports have had to compete for business from airlines, as well as from passengers and shippers."
