ATL to Host Drone Flight Over Runway

Pioneering project to survey runway; first U.S. airport to attain approval in airfield space

WHO: Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport and subcontractors

WHAT: ATL has received permission from the Federal Aviation Administration to allow

a subcontractor drone access in airspace over the world's busiest airport. The flight will survey and document runway pavement for future maintenance. Media members are invited to attend and observe, ask questions and obtain

video/photographs.
