## Hartsfield-Jackson Welcomes JetBlue to ATL

Airline begins nonstop service to Boston

**ATLANTA-** Atlanta Mayor Kasim Reed and officials from Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) will welcome JetBlue to ATL on Thursday, March 30. JetBlue begins nonstop service between ATL and Logan International Airport (BOS), with five daily flights between Atlanta and Boston.

"We are thrilled to welcome JetBlue as our newest airline partner," Airport General Manager Roosevelt Council, Jr. said today. "New airlines provide additional flight options for our guests and will help ATL maintain its status as the world's busiest and most efficient airport."
