ATL to Move Uber, Lyft Pick-Up Locations

Move provides curbside pick-up sites exclusively for rideshare passengers; new location opens August 16

ATLANTA – Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) officials will host a press walk-through and media avail Monday, August 14 to inform the public about changes in passenger pick-up locations for transportation network companies (TNCs), also known as rideshares. The new locations, developed in close consultation with the TNCs, will provide exclusive curbside pick-up access for TNCs and their customers. The move will take effect 12:01 a.m. August 16 and will expedite rideshare operations at the world's busiest and most efficient airport. Lyft and Uber began service at Hartsfield-Jackson January 1.
