"ATL Presents: Toyland" celebration to host 500 students

ATLANTA – Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) officials will host "ATL Presents: Toyland," a celebration of the holiday season for Airport-area schoolchildren Wednesday, Dec. 6. This year marks the 21st year ATL has hosted a holiday event for students in schools neighboring the Airport.
