# Hartsfield-Jackson Celebrates the Holiday Season

Tree lighting ceremony begins monthlong celebration of holiday events at world's busiest airport

**ATLANTA** – Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) officials prepare to kick off the holiday season with a tree lighting ceremony in the Airport's Domestic Terminal atrium on Wednesday, Nov. 29. ATL leaders will join diplomatic guests, holiday carolers, employees and volunteers to launch one of the busiest travel seasons of the year.

Immediately following the tree lighting ceremony, ATL's monthlong holiday celebration will begin. Live holiday music will entertain travelers throughout the Airport and post-security giftwrapping will be provided at centerpoints in the concourses from Dec. 12 through Dec. 24.

In addition to holiday decorations, a unique annual tradition continues in the Maynard H. Jackson Jr. International Terminal: 12 trees decorated by representatives of the Consular Corps office in Atlanta. Festively decorated to reflect each participating nation (Argentina, Canada, Costa Rica, Guyana, Haiti, India, Jamaica, Japan, Lithuania, Nigeria, Sweden, and Turkey), each tree will offer a distinct perspective.

On Wednesday, Dec. 6, more than 500 Airport-area first graders will participate in ATL Presents: Toyland. The annual program, now in its 21<sup>st</sup> year, aims to spread holiday cheer among metro Atlanta's youth while educating them about the role the Airport plays in the transportation industry. Airport partners and concessionaires will provide food and gifts to the students during the event. Santa is also expected to make surprise appearance.
