

**NOTICE OF
OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO
PASSENGER FACILITY CHARGE
Posted August 22, 2019**

The City of Atlanta is providing an opportunity for public comment until September 23, 2019 related to the proposed new Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) Application #21.

The City of Atlanta, operator of Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, plans to continue the maximum PFC allowable of \$4.50 per enplaned passenger. We anticipate collection to begin October 1, 2031 when the previous application is fully collected, with a total PFC revenue impact of \$128,000,000. The PFC expiration date for the project listed below is estimated to be May 1, 2032.

“Impose and Use” Project

21.1 Ramp 34 South Deicing Facility

This project includes the construction of a new common use aircraft deicing operation facility proximate to South Cargo and the Delta Technical Operations Center (TOC) 4 Hangar. This project will include new pavement, demolition of existing pavement, glycol storage and truck loading, spent fluid collection, a control system building, systems for glycol mixing and runoff containment, and a control center to coordinate aircraft movement and other supporting infrastructure such as a jet blast deflectors and retaining walls at the base of the ASR-9 tower. This project will also include modifications to Taxiway R to accommodate the South Deicing Facility. The facility and newly paved areas would be able to accommodate simultaneous deicing of five ADG-V aircraft or a mix of smaller aircraft. The total pavement incorporated into Ramp 34 will be approximately 208,000 square yards.

Construction for the project is scheduled to begin in December 2019 and anticipated to be completed in November 2021. The total cost for the project is estimated to be \$140,500,000 with PFC Pay-Go funding of \$128,000,000 and local funding of \$12,500,000.
