Badge Display and Challenging

All personnel in possession of ATL badges are required to display their badge at all times when in the secure, sterile, or SIDA areas of the Airport. Badges are to be worn on the outermost garment between the neck and waist.

Failure to display your badge in these areas may result in fines, badge suspension and/or revocation from TSA and/or DOA.

ATL employees should also remember to **CHALLENGE** individuals who are not displaying their badge in these areas.
