Escorting Policy

ATL SIDA badge holders with escorting privileges **cannot** escort the following:

- Persons who currently have an ATL SIDA badge (including lost, stolen, and unreturned badges as well as badges left at home).
- Persons who are in the vetting process to obtain an ATL SIDA badge.
- Persons with a non-SIDA badge.
- Persons with a public badge.
- Persons whose badge has been deactivated for any reason.

Employees who violate this policy are subject to a Breach of Rules Notice (BORN) citation and/or badge revocation.
