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### **Airport Prohibited Item Policy**

Airport employees are not allowed to have in their possession any prohibited items when attempting to access any controlled entry point (access door, perimeter gate, elevator, employee screening checkpoint, etc.).

Examples of prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- Guns, ammunition, or firearms
- Box cutters, razor blades or knives
- Illegal substances and relative paraphernalia
- Self-defense sprays (mace, pepper spray)
- Alcohol

Attempting to and/or bringing prohibited items into the Sterile, Secure and SIDA Areas of the airport will result in immediate badge revocation and possible fines from the TSA. You may also be subject to arrest.

**Remember, security is everybody's business!**
