## **New Security Training Requirement**

Effective Jan. 1, 2021, the Credentialing Office will require that new and renewal badge applicants complete the newly available Active Shooter Training online. For all online training, please visit <a href="https://atl.iet-ls.com">https://atl.iet-ls.com</a>.

The Active Shooter Training has been added to the list of required training on the new badge application released on Dec. 1.

Failure to complete required training will result in denial of badge issuance. A new badge appointment will be required for anyone who is turned away due to incomplete training.
