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Temporary Employee Security Screening Location

As of March 31, the Employee Security Screening Checkpoint (ESSC) located in the Domestic Terminal (mezzanine level) is permanently closed. **Employee Security Screening will be re-located to the TSA Screening Checkpoints.**

SIDA and Non-SIDA employees will be able to access the sterile area by utilizing the designated Airport Employee Lanes at the TSA North Security Screening Checkpoint (N-SSCP) during peak hours (4:00 am – 10:00 pm) and the TSA Main Security Screening Checkpoint (M-SSCP) during off-peak hours (10:00 pm- 4:00 am).

- **During peak hours, employees with liquids**, accessing the TSA N-SSCP, must utilize the appropriate lane, or their liquids will be confiscated.
- During off-peak hours, employees with liquids, accessing the TSA M-SSCP may utilize <u>ALL</u> lanes.
