National Insider Threat Awareness Month

September 2021 is the third annual National Insider Threat Awareness Month and is dedicated to raise awareness of the risks posed by insiders and to emphasize the importance of detecting, preventing, and reporting insider threats within an organization. This year's theme focuses on safety, security, the counterintelligence threat, recognizing and reporting indicators and the proactive nature of the Insider Threat programs.

What You Should Know About Insider Threats

- Insider incidents impact public and private organizations causing damage to national security, losses of life, and losses of classified information;
- Most insiders display concerning behaviors or risk indicators prior to engaging in relevant events;
- Immediately reporting suspicious activities allows insider threat program participants to take proactive measures that can lead to positive outcomes;
- Be aware of specific reporting procedures, protocols, and persons of contact at your organization;
- If you see something, say something. Your eyes and ears are a valuable resource in the continuing effort to maintain a safe airport environment;
- If you see something suspicious, dial 911.
