Proper Badge Usage

The ATL Security Identification Badge is issued to support job duties and responsibilities at the Airport and should be used for official business purposes only.

You should never use your Security Identification Badge for personal or off-duty use.

Airport employees are required to use and display their identification badge that identifies the company they are currently working for.

An employee with more than one employer and has been issued multiple badges cannot work for a company using a badge issued under a different company.

Companies and/or employees violating this directive will result in the loss of access privileges, fines and/or prosecution.
