Additional Security Audits

The Safety and Security Division conducts additional audits other than badge accountability.

Our Access Control Team routinely conducts audits of Access Levels and Work Schedules.

Badge access levels and the usage of doors, elevators, and vehicle gates are periodically reviewed to ensure the access need is still valid and to accommodate changes in the airport's security posture and to facilitate increased employee screening.

Work Schedule audits are conducted in direct coordination with the respective Authorized Signatory for the audited company. The work schedules for employees are compared to their badge usage to identify any anomalies or badge misuse.

The Badge Accountability, Access Level, and Work Schedule audits help secure Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.
