INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS EMPLOYEE SCREENING CHECKPOINT (IA-ESSC) CLOSURE JUNE 12, 2024

All employee screening will be conducted at the TSA International Arrivals Security Screening Checkpoint. The new employee security screening checkpoint location and hours are:

TSA has dedicated Lane 1 for employee screening.

The TSA-operated employee security screening process will be similar to the current process conducted by the DOA Security Contractor. However, there will be some differences. To adjust for the change in procedures, we advise employees to leave earlier on their first day using the new process.
