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New Identification Document Scanning Requirement

Effective October 31, 2024, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) now requires Airport Operators to scan and upload identification documents that applicants provide for processing.

The Credentialing Office has deployed new document scanners at each processing workstation to scan, name, save, and upload the required documents.

These additional tasks have increased the time it takes to process applicants at each workstation.

We are working to make these additional tasks as efficient as possible, but this will still ultimately require additional time for each appointment.

As we assess the impact of this new TSA requirement, we will make future adjustments to the appointment window to include the time necessary to complete these additional tasks.
