Parking Compliance/Restricted Parking Rules

- **No Parking in Hashed Areas**
Vehicles are not permitted to park in any hashed or striped areas. These areas are restricted to safety and emergency access.
- **No Parking in Non-Approved Locations**
Parking in areas not specifically designated or assigned to your work group is prohibited. Unauthorized parking in these locations may result in ticketing and towing.
- **Fire Apparatus Access**
Parking in front of fire apparatus or emergency equipment access points is strictly forbidden. These areas must always remain clear for emergency response.
- **Air Operations Area (AOA)**
The AOA includes taxiways, runways, loading ramps, vehicle roadways, and parking areas. Unauthorized parking in these restricted areas will result in immediate enforcement action, including ticketing and towing.

General Parking Rules

- Vehicles may only be parked in designated areas and must comply with posted signs, lines, and markings.
- Loading and unloading is permitted only in designated areas and only for the posted time limits.
- Reserved parking areas require a valid permit issued by the Aviation General Manager. Vehicles must display the proper insignia or markings.
- Vehicles found in violation of parking rules may be towed and impounded by airport police or city police officers if they create safety hazards, operational problems, or are abandoned.

Compliance Reminder: Parking violations—including stopping in hashed zones, non-approved spaces, or blocking emergency apparatus—will result in **ticketing and towing at the owner's expense**. These regulations protect not only airport operations but also the safety of staff, visitors, and emergency responders. **Please ensure your vehicle is parked only in your assigned or approved area and follow all directional and regulatory signage.**
