

VOLUNTARY NOTICE OF POTENTIAL BOND ISSUANCE

July 2, 2026

CITY OF ATLANTA AIRPORT GENERAL REVENUE BONDS

The City of Atlanta (the “**City**”) is proposing to issue one or more series or subseries of Airport General Revenue Bonds (the “**Series 2026 Bonds**”) totaling approximately \$1.1 billion* in aggregate principal amount. The Series 2026 Bonds are expected to be issued as a combination of tax-exempt AMT (approximately \$710 million*) and non-AMT (approximately \$400 million*) bonds. The Series 2026 Bonds are expected to price during the week of August 10, 2026* through a syndicate led by BofA Securities, Inc. and Siebert Williams Shank & Co., LLC.

If and when issued, the City expects to designate one or more series or subseries of the Series 2026 Bonds as “Green Bonds” based upon, among other things, a second party opinion, which is expected to be rendered by Kestrel, an independent external reviewer with expertise with respect to The Green Bond Principles established by the International Capital Market Association. Currently, the City estimates approximately \$700 million* of the Series 2026 Bonds will be designated as Green Bonds.

If and when issued, the Series 2026 Bonds will be issued under and pursuant to the Restated and Amended Master Bond Ordinance adopted by the City Council of the City (the “**City Council**”) on March 20, 2000, as previously amended and supplemented (the “**Master Bond Ordinance**”), particularly as supplemented by that certain Thirty-Ninth Supplemental Bond Ordinance adopted by the City Council on May 4, 2026 and approved by the Mayor of the City (the “**Mayor**”) on May 8, 2026, as supplemented by that certain Confirming Ordinance expected to be adopted by the City Council and approved by the Mayor on or about August 11, 2026* (together, the “**Thirty-Ninth Supplemental Bond Ordinance**”). The Master Bond Ordinance and the Thirty-Ninth Supplemental Bond Ordinance are hereinafter referred to as the “**Bond Ordinance**.” Unless otherwise defined herein, capitalized terms used in this Voluntary Notice of Potential Bond Issuance (the “**Voluntary Notice**”) shall have the meanings set forth in the Bond Ordinance.

If and when issued, the proceeds of the Series 2026 Bonds will be used for the purpose of providing funds to, among other things: (a) finance or refinance the costs of planning, engineering, designing, acquiring, equipping and constructing of all or a portion of certain improvements to the Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (the “**Airport**”); (b) fund deposits to the applicable subaccounts of the Debt Service Reserve Account to meet the Debt Service Reserve Requirements related to the Series 2026 Bonds; (c) fund deposits to the applicable subaccounts of the Construction Fund to pay capitalized interest (if any); and (d) pay certain costs of issuance with respect to the Series 2026 Bonds.

The Series 2026 Bonds will be special limited obligations of the City payable from and secured by a pledge of and Senior Lien on Airport General Revenues on a parity with the

Outstanding Senior Lien Airport General Revenue Bonds and any other Additional Bonds issued on a parity with such Outstanding Senior Lien General Revenue Bonds under the Bond Ordinance, and the security terms will be similar to those for the Outstanding Senior Lien Airport General Revenue Bonds.

The City reserves the right to: (a) change the timing and size of the sale and the structure of the potential transaction; (b) not issue any or certain of the Series 2026 Bonds, both of which will be based upon, among other things, market conditions existing at such time; and (c) not designate one or more of the series or subseries of the Series 2026 Bonds as Green Bonds and/or revise the amounts of such series or subseries of the Series 2026 Bonds to be designated as Green Bonds.

The publication of this Voluntary Notice does not constitute an offer to sell or the solicitation of an offer to buy any Series 2026 Bonds, nor will there be any sale of the Series 2026 Bonds by any person in any jurisdiction in which it is unlawful for such person to make an offer, solicitation, or sale. Any such offer or solicitation will only be made pursuant to a preliminary official statement and a final official statement that prospective investors should review in its entirety before making any investment decision. No investment decision should be made in reliance upon the information contained in this Voluntary Notice.

The information in this Voluntary Notice has been compiled from sources believed to be reliable, certain of which has not been independently verified. No representation or warranty, express or implied, is provided in relation to the fairness, accuracy, completeness or reliability of such information or any opinions or conclusions relating to such information. By making this Voluntary Notice, the City does not undertake to make any additional filings not otherwise required by its continuing disclosure undertakings in connection with Rule 15c2-12 promulgated by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission.

The information in this Voluntary Notice is current as of the date hereof, and there may be events that occur subsequent to such date that could have a material adverse effect on the information that is presented herein. The City has not undertaken any obligation to update any information in this Voluntary Notice.
